 - Amend all the district policies to clarify that where development is proposed on identified surface car park sites in the town and group centres, car parking allocation provides for the development and makes a substantial contribution to the long term parking supply for the town or group centre.
 - Amend Assessment Requirement 1 in the Residential Zones Policy about site coverage for single dwellings to add a note to clarify that single dwelling includes all associated Class 10 buildings.
 - Amend Assessment Requirements 2 & 3 in the Residential Zones Policy to clarify that site coverage for multi unit housing in the RZ1-RZ5 zones is calculated on the original block area where the block is to be subdivided under the *Planning Act 2023*.
 - Amend Assessment Requirement 14 in the Subdivision Policy to clarify that DAs for multi unit housing (including dual occupancy development), on blocks considered to be non-standard blocks in the RZ1 zone under the previous Territory Plan, that were approved, lodged or substantially submitted before 17/11/2023, these developments can still be unit titled.
 - Amend definition of Industrial Trades in Part G Dictionary to include plant and equipment hire as an example use.
